

## The AAU-led UA Project

Launched in Accra on 13 April 2023 by the AAU and ICANN under the Coalition for Digital Africa initiative



### **Universal Acceptance Project**

Aims to increase the number of African higher education institutions that are UA-ready (to at least 200) by June 2025.



**Objective 1** 

Evaluate the UA readiness of the AAU members (higher education institutions) and create a baseline.

#### **Objective 2**

Create awareness of and develop capacity for UA within academic institutions







#### **Objective 3**

Support higher education institutions to incorporate UA and internationalized domain names into their IT/CS curricula.



Encourage higher education and research institutions to participate in the work of the UA Steering Group

### Anglophone Deans / HODs of Faculty Curriculum Workshop
